GENERAL

The Grand Assembly of Alaska Scholarship is available to Alaskan Rainbow Girls or Alaskan Majority members in pursuit of continuing education. Graduating high school seniors, or girls currently attending college, are eligible to apply. The award amount is established at \$500. This scholarship is open to any course of study. Deadline for submission is April 15 each year. Applications received later than April 15 will not be accepted for consideration. The recipient of the scholarship will be announced at Grand Assembly.

SPECIFIC

Personal Essay. Provide your own personal history in Rainbow, i.e. your age when you joined, what offices were held and how long, and what service projects you were involved in. Describe what you feel Rainbow gave to you: how it affected your decisions and the direction you have chosen to take in your life.

Describe your plans for college, your educational goals and objectives, your plans and time frame for meeting these goals and your plans for utilizing your education after you receive your degree or certificate. Be specific as possible about your goals and objectives, and the reasons you are choosing this form of higher education.

This essay should be no less than one page and no longer than two pages.

Eligibility. Applications must be accompanied by two written letters of recommendation: one from the girl's Advisory Board and the other from an educator from the school which the girl attends.

Provide copies of current or most recent high school or college transcripts or equivalent G.E.D. test results. SAT or ACT test scores if available (not mandatory).

Once the scholarship is awarded, it is required that verification of enrollment or certification from the College Registrar be provided. Funds will be disbursed to the Registrar's Office. The recipient will be presented with a Certificate of Award at Grand Assembly.
